### November Common Assessment

Parents and Guardians, the first round of common assessments are coming on Monday 11/12 and Tuesday 11/13/18. The Common Assessment is an important benchmark that helps predict STAAR readiness, and it is also worth 7% of your student's semester grade. It is very important that your child is in attendance on these two days to ensure they perform at their very best. Please be sure your student gets plenty of rest, and comes in with pencils, a book, and a positive attitude prior to these test days! They will be taking the common assessment during their **regularly scheduled class period** and our schedule will be very tight! It is **EXTREMELY** important students make it to school on time these two days

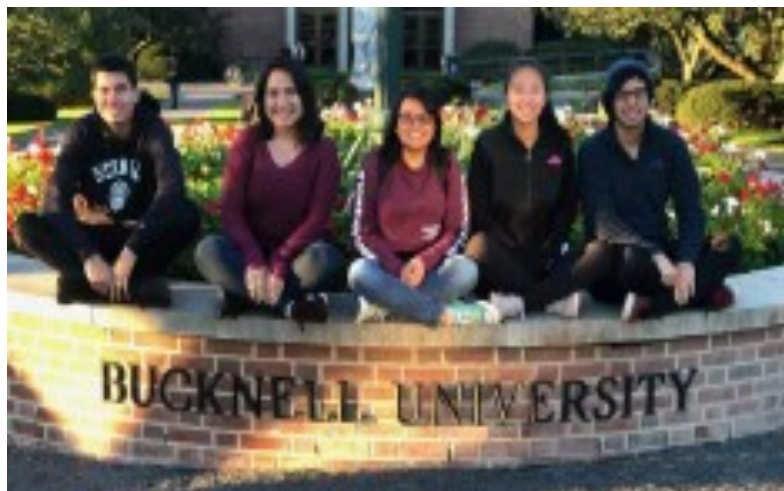
