The pandemic has created incredible economic challenges in our country and in our communities. We know that many of our families have not claimed their stimulus funds. Recently, the rules changed to increase accessibility, which may impact our families. ### COVID-19 Vaccines

As a reminder, YES Prep has partnered with HEB to provide the Moderna two-dose COVID-19 vaccine via vaccine clinics at several of our campuses. These vaccines are FREE to all YES Prep staff, students and families who are 18 years of age or older. **As clinics become available at our campuses, our staff will be in touch with you directly with instructions on how to sign up for an appointment.**

We will have four more clinics distributing vaccines on Friday, April 30 (see table below). **If your child is a student at one of these campuses, our staff will be in touch with you directly with instructions on how to sign up for an appointment.** For our remaining campuses, we will be rolling out more clinics in the coming weeks. STAAR is an important data point for our students, campuses, and district. If you have not yet already, please review the information [on this site](#).

All campuses will be running their regular bus routes on STAAR days. If your student needs to take the bus on their testing day(s), please refer to your campus's most updated routes and stops to find the stop most convenient for your student. The most current routes and stops are posted on your campus website and will be posted through social media. If you need any assistance, please contact the front office of your campus. If a bus is full before reaching all stops, a second bus will be dispatched to complete the route, or the original bus will drop off the students on campus and then complete the rest of the route.
