YES Prep will be offering a Distance Learning Summer Credit Recovery program for any high school student that did not earn a passing grade for a core course during the 2019-2020 School Year. Due to the current closure, our Summer Credit Recovery program will be offered through an online platform called Edumentum PLATO (currently used for Spring Credit Recovery). YES Prep staff supporting students during Summer Credit Recovery will continue to utilize Microsoft Teams for communicating with students and hosting office hours and tutorials. Our goal is to ensure YES Prep students that would benefit from regaining the credit prior to the next school year have the opportunity to do so. As a reminder, the grading policy during the closure has been included below.

 Grading During Keep YES Prep Learning: For A6, students will receive equally weighted, achievement-based grades on assignments based on the mini-lessons in each class. Grades in A6 can only improve students' scores for the semester; as such, we encourage students to correct their work, but we will not offer graded reassessment opportunities. Common Assessment 2 will still count as 7% of the semester grade, except for courses that did not test prior to closure.

The YES Prep Credit Recovery program will be available for 9th – 12th grade students that need to regain a first semester or second semester core course(s) (Math, English, Social Studies, or Science). Students and families will be informed of final grades by Friday, May 29, 2020 when the Report Cards

Purpose

YES Prep will be offering a Distance Learning Summer Credit Recovery program for any high school student that did not earn a passing grade for a core course during the 2019-2020 School Year. Due to the current closure, our Summer Credit Recovery program will be offered through an online platform called Edumentum PLATO (currently used for Spring Credit Recovery).

The YES Prep Credit Recovery program will be available for 9th – 12th grade students that need to regain a first semester or second semester core course(s) (Math, English, Social Studies, or Science).

In order to earn credit for the course, the student must successfully complete the program by July 1, 2020 with a passing grade. Failure to do so will result in the student not earning credit. Depending on the course or the number of missing credits, the student will be retained or need to re-enroll in the course the following year putting them behind in the credits needed to graduate.





Important Information

Cost	•Free of charge •Due to the impact of COVID, Summer Credit Recovery for the 2019-2020 School Year will be free of charge to families. Please note that this is a one-time cost waived and future Credit Recovery will have an associated cost.	
Credit Recover Dates	•June 4: Mandatory student and family virtual meeting will take place to ensure students and families know how to sign into the program and check their progress and have an opportunity to meet the summer staff that will be supporting their student •June 8 – July 1: During this window, students can work on their course(s) as their own pace. Regular office hours will be held Microsoft Teams to support students struggling with the content.	
Grades	•The Summer Credit Recovery grading policy will closely mirror the Keep YES Prep Learning Grading Policy. Any work not turned in will receive a 50% and the lowest a student can receive from any turned in assignments is a 70%.	
Technolo	•If your student is currently using a YES Prep Laptop you will receive guidance on when the laptop should be returned. If your student needs to take Credit Recovery, and is currently using a YES Prep Laptop, they can continue to use it for Summer Credit Recovery and return it at the end of the program. If your student needs to obtain a YES Prep Laptop, please contact your student's home campus.


Staff availability

Staff will be available Monday – Friday from 9 am - 4 pm


- Parents and students can contact staff through email, Teams chat or phone call






How do I know if my student is doing the work?



Unit Pre-test


- Students who master the pre-test (70% or higher) are exempt from taking that unit
- We recommend that students take as much time as possible on the pre-test as it could save them time from completing other assingments





Locked assignments

- If a student does not master a test or exam after 3 attempts with a 70%, the test will "lock".
- Students need to reach out to their Advisory Teacher to unlock the assignment after they have attended the Content Teacher's office hours or asked the Content Teacher for help





Home situation that is affecting work progress



My student is logged in... now what

Students need to log in to Edmentum daily

Students need to check Teams daily

Students need to attend Office Hours

Students need to check in with their Advisory Teachers

If an assignment is locked, students need to reach out to their Advisory Teachers



How often should my student be completing work?



The program is self-paced, there is no time limit when completing work. We recommend students spend an hour a day per class. If they are taking one class = one hour per day. Two classes = two hours per day.



Students should be logging into Edmentum daily to stay on pace to finish on time



Students should attend Office Hours, once posted and if they cannot make the posted hours, they need to reach out to the Content Teacher to set a separate time



All work needs to be completed on Edmentum by 4:00 pm on Wednesday, July 1st. No extensions will be granted



Are office hours mandatory?

Office Hours led by Content Teachers are the only time students will have to get questions answered if they are struggling with the material on Edmentum

Exams will automatically lock after 3 tries – students will need to attend office hours to get the content necessary to master the exam

Content teachers will be available through their Teams Channel or through chat
