Maintaining Health and Safety:

To reduce the risk of transmission YES Prep Public Schools plans the following mitigation strategies for the 2021-2022 school year (per current CDC guidelines):

- Proper handwashing encouraged
- Hand sanitizer available
- Optional wearing of masks (as written in Executive Order No. GA-36 signed May 18, 2021)
- Targeted cleaning as appropriate (especially high contact areas)
- Positive cases will be reported to the local health department
- Local vaccination sites/providers available on our website
- Appropriate accommodations for students with disabilities as identified in the student's Individualized Education Program

Ensuring Continuity of Services:

YES Prep will continue to take appropriate actions to ensure continuity of services to students. These actions will focus on addressing students' academic, social, emotional, and mental health needs. Proposed plans to provide a continuity of services are as follows:

- Continue to provide high quality on-grade level instruction with scaffolded supports for all students.
- Provide instructional materials/resources, activities and outreach to meet the needs of students.
- Provide social and emotional/counseling, wellness supports to students and professional development (training) to staff.
- Provide technology updates and improve infrastructure and connectivity.
- Provide summer enrichment opportunities to accelerate learning.
- Provide staff development to accelerate learning.
- Provide a robust and effective tutorial program during the school day, after the school day, and on Saturdays that addresses unfinished learning for identified students.
- Create intervention-focused elementary & secondary data reports to monitor student progress.
- Create systems and structures that enable rigorous, active, and aligned 1:1 blended learning, increasing college readiness and personalized learning.
- Provide additional staff to oversee interventions and tutorial programs.
